There are two dedicated groups of volunteers who love the Granite Dells and are working actively to protect land for a Granite Dells Regional Park and Preserve.

Save the Dells is a political action committee that has worked to get a win-win-deal involving the public, the City of Prescott, and the Arizona Eco Development to protect vital acreage along the Peavine and Iron King Trails. It has mobilized thousands of citizens to support negotiations to literally “save the Dells.” The PAC will continue to step up on any issues that threaten the integrity of this amazing local resource.

The **Granite Dells Preservation Foundation**, founded in 2010, is an apolitical non-profit that focuses on fundraising for land purchase and conservation easements, outreach, education, and ongoing stewardship efforts.
